Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are your hours of operation?

A: The Miller Park Camp is open from 7am-6pm Monday through Friday starting on June 1st through August 5th.

Q: What dates are you closed this summer?

A: We are closed Friday, June 19th, Friday, June 26th, Friday, July 3rd, and Friday July 10th.

Q: What ages of children are eligible to attend the camp?

A: Children who are currently in Kindergarten through Fifth grade can attend the camp.

Q: What is the cutoff time for daily arrival?

A: Campers must arrive by 10am each day to ensure they can participate in camp field trips and activities.

Q: My child has other obligations during the week; how often do they need to attend the camp to keep their spot?

A: Campers must attend 3 days per week in order to keep their spot at the camp.

Q: I don't want my child to be in the pool. Can my child still attend camp?

A: Your child may still attend camp but they must be picked up prior to swimming field trips.

Q: How do I enroll my child?

A: Complete a registration form and wait for confirmation from the Camp Director.

Q: Is there a cost to attend Miller Park Summer Camp?

A: No. There is no cost for the summer camp!
